BACKGROUND



- Currently 1 million Afghan Refugees are living in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.
- Repatriation started in 2002. A total of 703,022 families consisting 3,918,832 individuals have repatriated till end of December 2015 from Pakistan.
- Presently, 0.639 million Registered Afghan Refugees are living in 43 administered camps in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa besides another 0.2 million registered Afghan Refugees are residing in urban areas.

REFUGEE AFFECTED AREAS (RAA):

Those areas which had been inhabited by Afghan Refugees in the past. (Led by P&DD and UNDP)

REFUGEE HOSTING AREAS (RHA):

Those areas which are still inhabited by Afghan Refugees.(Led by CAR & UNHCR)



OBJECTIVES OF HA COMPONENT




- To compensate the hosting communities by rehabilitating their affected resources covering social, economic, health, education & livelihood facilities.

Main donors:



RAHA Budget: by Area (2009-2015)





- Provision of furniture & other related Equipment
- Training of Teachers

 Upgradation of reservoirs and boring/digging of wells; installation of tube wells & hand/pressure pumps; rehabilitation or supply & fixing and Upgradation of pipe schemes.
